**Pedestrian and Cycle Accessibility Improvements to Bruche and Chapelford**

Thank you for your letter dated 20 April 2010 regarding the proposed pedestrian and cycle accessibility improvements in the Great Sankey area. It is good to learn that Great Sankey Parish Council is in favour of the proposed measures being taken forward.

Unfortunately, there is no scope at the present time to extend the proposed Lingley Green Avenue segregated footway/cycleway beyond Barrowhall Lane as the funding that was awarded to the Council by the Government to deliver Warrington's Community Infrastructure scheme is fully committed to a range of sustainable infrastructure schemes within the Great Sankey and Woolston areas. However, the Council does have an aspiration to continue the route in the future subject to the relevant funding be made available.

I will contact you in due course as soon as I have further information regarding the construction dates of the proposed schemes.
